What if I do not like the Judgment?

There are several options if you do not like your Judgement following a hearing or trial. One option is to appeal the Judgement, or the ruling to a higher court. The other option is to look for grounds to file a motion to reconsider. The purpose for a Motion to Reconsider is, one, to bring the courts attention to changes in law, two, an error in the trial courts application of existing law, or three, bring up newly discovered evidence that existed but was not available at
